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Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are well and staying safe.

As a specialist provision, we are continually adapting and evolving in order to meet the complex needs of our students. As of September, we have decided that Key Stage 3 pupils (Years 7-9) will be set into classes of need and style of learning, rather than the traditional setting of year groups. This will better enable us to precision teach so that our pupils are able to make better academic progress.

When we return full time in September, pupils will be put into their new groups which will become their new bubble. They will spend the first two to three weeks focusing on core skills and a whole school project on Manchester with each group having its own focus. This will present opportunities for teamwork and relationship building as well as covering a broad range of subjects. It also allows us the chance to take into account any changes in health guidance that may occur over the summer holidays.

After these two / three weeks, and dependent on health advice at that time, pupils will then be given their timetables and subject based lessons will be resume.
